

THE DENNISTOUN TREASURE HUNT - TEACHER SHEET

From Thursday May 7th to Thursday May 14th each of the shops named on the entry form sheet will have one unusual thing in the window not normally connected with that shop. For example, a flower shop might have a toy car in the window. The children should write down what the unusual thing is in the space after the shop name on the other side of this sheet. All objects will be seen in the shop windows, so please ask the children not to bother people working in the shops. Also, don't forget the bonus library question at the end!

When the sheet has been completed, it should be handed back in to the teacher. All sheets should have the name, class, teacher and school boxes filled in.

- **Every child who hands in a form with answers will get a sticker and a certificate. We have supplied certificates to the school, so could you please fill in the child's name when they hand in a completed form, and present them with a certificate and stickers.**
- **Every child in the class that returns the most forms will get a strawberry tart thanks to the generosity of James Allen bakers on Alexandra Parade.**
- **There will be two main prizes, one each for the boy and the girl with the most correct answers.**

If there is more than one sheet with all the answers right, the winners will be picked at Dennistoun New Church Hall at 12 noon on Saturday May 16th. If the winner can't be there, don't worry, we'll let the school know who has won a prize and the winner can collect it from their school.

Younger children should be with their parents or older brothers and sisters while looking at the shop windows, and everyone should only cross Duke Street at the proper crossings. If pupils have friends who live in Dennistoun, but go to schools outside the area, they'll be able to collect entry forms from Dennistoun Library.

We would also like everyone to know that we are also holding a family event called the *Wild Goose Chase*, which will include fun *Tasks* and *Quests* in and around around Dennistoun on Saturday May 16th, starting at the Dennistoun New Church Hall on Armadale Street, at noon, straight after the announcement.
