Teams are invited to compete for a specially commissioned trophy and a grand prize of local meals out, plus other treats and gifts.**

The main event, will be kicked off at 12 noon with an announcement of who has won the children's Treasure Hunt that will have taken place throughout the preceding week. Every primary age child has been invited to take part in the treasure hunt via the schools and the library. By spotting "wrong" items in local shop windows the boy and girl with the keenest eye will each win a £50 games voucher.

Participants in teams of up to six will start their Wild Goose Chase at the Dennistoun New Church Hall. There will be a round of **fantastic fun fair** sideshow games to get the event under way. The route then continues via the Reidvale Adventure Playground where we will be hosting a **silly sports session**.

At the halfway point there's a **quirky quick quiz** at Dennistoun Library. The route ends at the WASPS artists' studios on Hanson Street, where there will be a chance to indulge in some **amazing arty activities** in association with the Parade Artists Spring Show.

In addition, a series of questions have been set to test your powers of observation en route, with a cunning quest to uncover the details of Dennistoun's hidden surroundings and a further chance to add to the to the points total.

When the deadline for entries closes at 4pm, the totals will be tallied and the winning team will be presented with the special trophy and the local prize bonanza.
