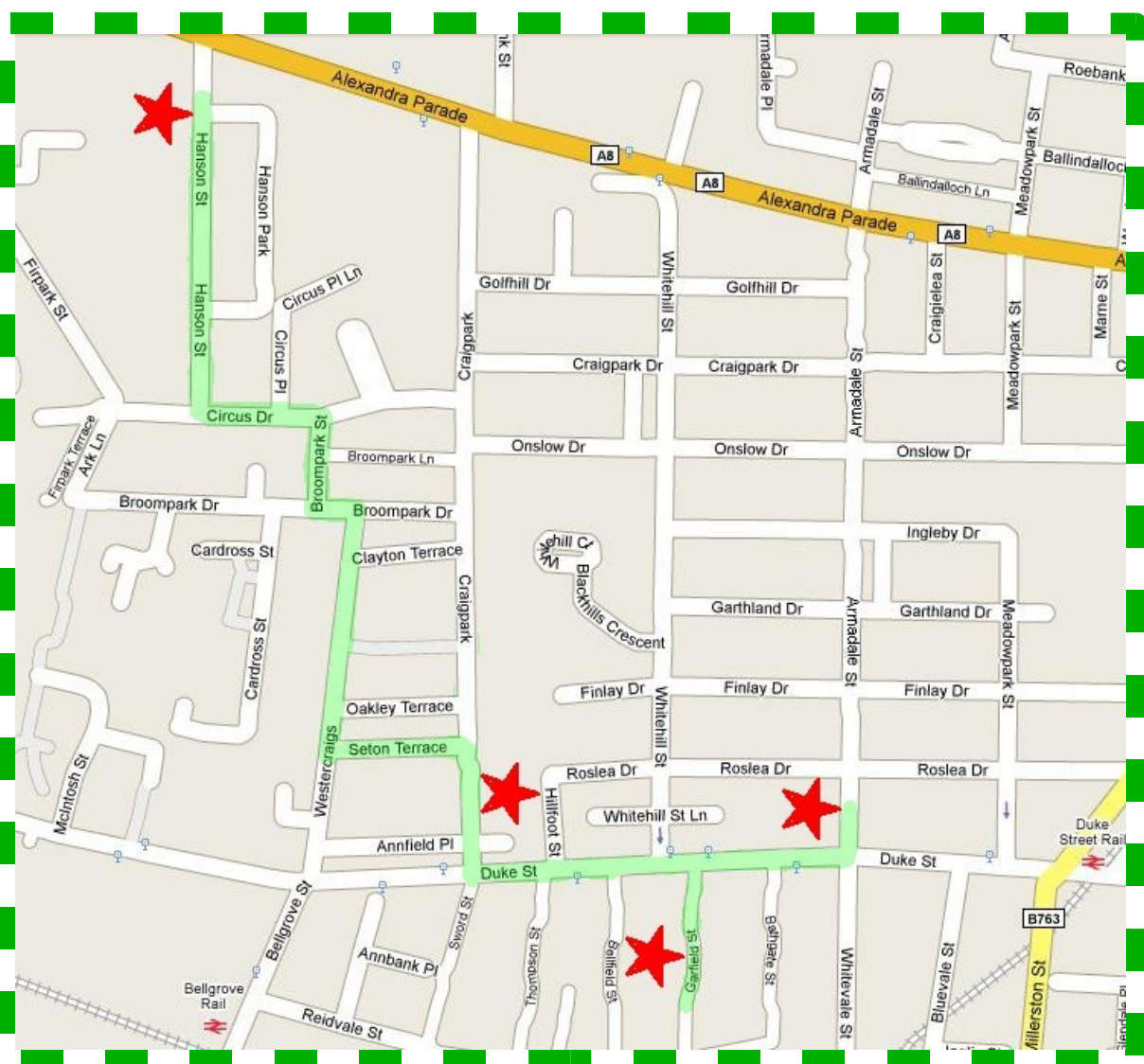

## DENNISTOUN NEW CHURCH HALL -----> RAPA

- 1. What day are the pipes and drums?**

*...turn right onto Broompark Street...*
  - 19. Where can't you go at the moment?**  
*Broompark Lane / 'The Alley'*  
*...turn left onto Circus Drive and cross over...*
  - 20. How many birds are there above the heart?**  
*Zero (two below, so 'two' accepted also)*  
*...turn right onto Hanson Street...*
  - 21. Is it the boys or the girls entrance visible above the old school door?**  
*Girls*
  - 22. How much is a Real Full Valet?**  
*£45*
  - 23. Which three house names can be seen from the gates of the nursing home?**  
*Alexander, Craigpark and Dennistoun*
  - 24. How many butterflies in the porch?**  
*Four (plastic, in the house next to WASPS)*
  - 25. What are the fruits on the Café Sejuiced signage?**  
*Avocado and plums*  
*...enter WASPS studios (see opposite)...*
  - 26. Which object is the goose next to?**  
*Next to an object marked 'Blue Tower'*
